He joined Enbridge Pipelines Inc. in Edmonton in 1994, after spending part of his early career as a Policy Advisor to two federal Energy Ministers in Ottawa, and in Corporate Affairs roles with an electricity and natural gas utility. MBA from the Haskayne School of Business and a BA in Political Science from the University of Regina.

Byron is a Trustee of the Canadian Museum of Nature and has served on the Cabinet of the Calgary United Way Campaign and as the Utilities and Natural Resources Sector lead for the United Way of Greater Toronto & Area.
