As President, Gas Pipelines, Leon Zupan is responsible for the overall leadership of Enbridge's Gas Pipelines businesses in Canada and the U.S. including the Company's interests in the Alliance and Vector pipelines, its established midstream natural gas operations in the U.S. and growing interests in both the U.S. and Canada; and its extensive network of offshore pipelines in the Gulf of Mexico. Mr. Zupan is based in Houston.

Mr. Zupan has more than 25 years' experience at Enbridge across a range of the Company's businesses. He served most recently as Senior Vice President, Operations overseeing Enbridge's US and Canadian liquids pipelines. Mr. Zupan joined Enbridge in 1987 as part of the Engineering group and held increasingly senior

management positions in Sarnia and Edmonton in Operations, Shipper Services and IT. In 2000, he was promoted to Vice President, Development and Services based in Calgary, and served in that position until moving to Edmonton in 2004 and Houston in 2012.

He has been active in his community as a member of the United Way Campaign Cabinet and Vice Chair of the Board of Directors for the Alberta Capital Region and Chaired the 2008 city wide campaign. Mr. Zupan also served as a Board member and President of the Alberta Chamber of Resources and sits on the Boards of Alliance Pipeline, Aux Sable and Enbridge Energy

Mr. Zupan graduated from the University of Alberta with a Bachelor of Science in Physics.
