Conflict Mineral Policy

1. Purpose

Forum Energy Technologies, Inc. (“Forum” or the “Company”) is committed to maintaining the highest standard of ethical conduct and is concerned with humanitarian and environmental abuses associated with the mining, transportation and trade of certain minerals from conflict-affected regions of the world, including the Democratic Republic of Congo (the “Covered Countries”). To that end and in connection with the enactment of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act of 2010 (the “Dodd-Frank Act”), Forum is compelled to determine whether its products contain tantalum (columbite-tantalite), tin (cassiterite), tungsten (wolframite), or gold (collectively, “3TG”) sourced from the Covered Countries and used to finance armed groups in the region. As such, Forum desires to examine its supply chain on an annual basis to determine whether parts and components used in Forum’s products contain 3TG. Forum is committed to working with its suppliers to determine the source and chain of custody of parts and components that contain 3TG. Forum expects its suppliers to conduct their operations in an ethical manner and in accordance with applicable laws and Forum’s other policies that apply to them.

11. Scope

This Policy applies to all Forum product lines. Forum requests that all its partners, subcontractors, and suppliers adopt and enforce this Policy as it pertains to review of 3TG products.

111. Steering Committee

A committee consisting of a representative from each product line, the Legal Department, Finance & Accounting, and Internal Audit shall be established and meet periodically. Each member of the Steering Committee shall be responsible for their respective department or product line’s compliance with this Policy and requirements set forth in the Company’s Conflict Minerals Manual.

1V. Compliance with laws

These policies and procedures are in compliance with applicable law, including compliance with the Securities and Exchange Commissions’ final rule implementing Section 1502 of the Dodd Frank Act.

V. Transparency and Reporting
