Update on Share Repurchase Program 2017

In the framework of the Share Repurchase Program 2017, as announced on February 16, 2017, the Company reports today that during the period from September 11 until September 15, 2017, the following transactions took place through the central order book of the regulated market of Euronext Brussels:

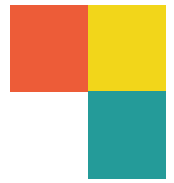
