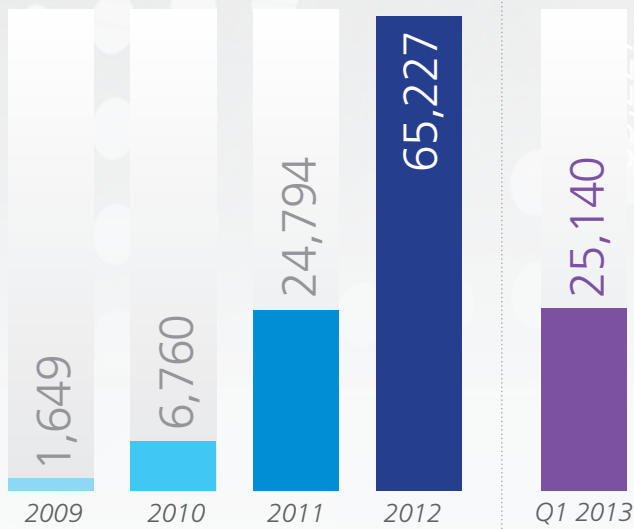


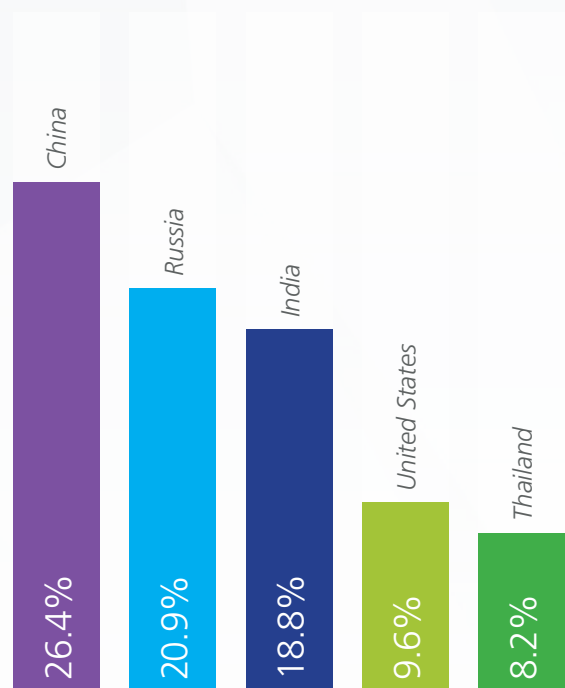
In the first quarter of 2013, NQ Mobile identified 25,140 new threats - that's more discoveries than 2011 and more than 38% of the 2012 annual total.

### Q1 2013 Top 5 Infected Markets

- China remained the most infected market, increasing nearly 4% over 2012.
- Russia's infection rate increased by 17% to move ahead of India, which saw a 3% decrease.
- United States remained at 9.6%, while Thailand replaced Saudi Arabia in the top 5.



### Q1 2013 Highlights

- Over 25,000 threats were discovered in 1Q 2013
- NQ Mobile estimated that over 10 million devices were infected in 1Q 2013.
- **Mobile phone Trojan infects PC:** In February 2013 a new type of mobile malware was discovered that could jump from an Android device to infect the PC. More information on this discovery can be found [here](#).
