## Explanation of Responses

(1) Performance-based restricted stock units, which vested on June 16, 2017, converted into common stock on a one-for-one basis. (2) 653 shares were withheld (not sold into the market) on June 16, 2017 for the purpose of paying the income tax obligations upon vesting of performance-based restricted stock units. (3) Upon vesting, 1 share of common stock was issued for each restricted stock unit. (4) 70 shares were withheld (not sold into the market) on August 1, 2017 for the purpose of paying the income tax obligations upon vesting of restricted stock units. (5) The options with respect to the shares of common stock are currently exercisable. (6) Restricted Stock Units are awarded under the Company's Omnibus Award Plan with 925 units scheduled to vest on each April 1, 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2020. (7) Restricted Stock Units are awarded under the Company's Omnibus Award Plan with 134 units scheduled to vest on August 1, 2017 and 133 shares on each August 1, 2018 and 2019.
