



LATAM Airlines Group reports preliminary monthly statistics for June 2018

Santiago, Chile, July 9, 2018– LATAM Airlines Group S.A. and its subsidiaries, (“LATAM Airlines Group” or “the Company”) (NYSE: LTM / IPSA: LTM), the leading airline group in Latin America, today reported its preliminary monthly traffic statistics for June 2018 compared to June 2017.

System passenger traffic increased 1.3%, while capacity rose by 6.4%. As a result, the Company’s load factor for the month fell 4.1 percentage points to 80.3%. International passenger traffic accounted for approximately 59% of the month’s total passenger traffic.

The following table summarizes traffic figures for the month and includes a year-to-date breakdown for LATAM’s main business units.
