Responsibilities

- Lead the annual budgeting process for the wind portfolio, including the coordination with various stakeholders across the organization.
- Leading a team to analyze monthly, quarterly, and annual results; and produce comprehensive reports for senior management and outside stakeholders such as lenders and tax equity investors.
- Overseeing normal course lender and tax equity interactions and drive month/quarter/year end deliverables.
- Support/manage ad hoc projects to advance corporate objectives.
- Provide support to the Senior Director, FP&A and Director, Corporate FP&A, as needed.
