

## **U.S. Army Awards \$3.8 Million in Orders for Deployable Satellite Systems Equipment From TeleCommunication Systems**

Initial funding on the orders totals \$1.3 million and the orders will be funded up to a total of \$3.8 million if the options are fully exercised through August 2011. The U.S. Army Project Manager for the Warfighter Information Network-Tactical (PM WIN-T) Commercial Satellite Terminal Program (CSTP) is funding these procurements through the Army's \$5 billion World-Wide Satellite Systems (WWSS) contract vehicle.
