

IENOVA ANNOUNCES THE CLOSING OF THE ACQUISITION OF THE “VENTIKA” WIND GENERATION FACILITY

Mexico City, December 15th, 2016 – Infraestructura Energética Nova, S.A.B. de C.V., “**IEnova**”, in accordance with its September 5th 2016 announcement, informs that today it closed the transactions contemplated by the purchase and sale agreement to acquire 100% of the equity interest in the Ventika and Ventika II wind generation facilities, jointly “**Ventika**”, developed by CEMEX and Fisterra, with sellers Blackstone Energy Partners, Fisterra Energy and other minority shareholders.

The transaction was approved by Mexico’s Antitrust Commission (*Comisión Federal de Competencia Económica*).

Ventika consists of 84 wind turbines, with an installed power generation capacity of 252 megawatts, making it the largest operating wind farm in Mexico and one of the largest in Latin America. Located in the General Bravo municipality in the state of Nuevo León, Ventika was jointly developed by Fisterra Energy and Cemex and began commercial operations in April 2016. CEMEX Energía will remain as the manager of the windfarm facilities.

Its power generation and capacity are contracted through long-term, U.S. dollar denominated agreements with high credit rating private customers.

This transaction, which will enhance IEnova’s renewables portfolio, is consistent with IEnova’s strategic plan to focus on short and mid-term growth. This transaction also reflects IEnova’s commitment to exercise investment discipline by investing in assets which are contracted with long-term and U.S. dollar denominated agreements. This transaction will contribute significantly and immediately to IEnova’s earnings.
